MISSION

Our programme allows idea owners (employees from different grades and parts of our client's firm) to create an innovative venture which they can bring to life. Each idea owner works alongside a designer (you) and they act as a close-knit team, with whom they can bounce ideas off of throughout the 6 weeks.

We will be focusing on creating a visual representation of an idea. You will be working towards producing something low-fidelity which highlights important features that the idea-owner can then pitch to leadership and execs. You will be required to delegate what the idea should look like- which will most likely be a digital solution- however, it could also be a service or proof of concept.

DATES

The innovation programme will run from the 11th of October until the 15th of November. We will require you to:

- Meet your idea-owner for an hour on 18th October
- Attend the 4 full sprint days (on-site work in London) on 25th October, 1st, 8th, 15th November

We also expect 2-3 days of additional work that can be done remotely.

OUTCOMES

We require a talented designer who will support her or his idea owner as well as own the client relationship. To succeed in this role, you'll need to:

- do UX research and define product requirements
- create prototypes and high fidelity UI designs
- create a kick-ass pitch deck that will bring a story to life
- act as an excited team member that solves problems with the idea owner

Good communications skills are a must to understand the brief and requirements in order to then guide the idea-owner on product design. We want someone who exceeds simple execution and someone who can bring their enthusiasm to the sprint. We hire people that truly care about our mission and who take pride in their own work. There is a high level of freedom and autonomy in the project and we expect people to take ownership.
